### Track Guide & Scripture Overview

1. For Unto Us – Isaiah 9:6

A prophetic anthem celebrating the long-awaited promise of a Savior, fulfilled in Jesus, the Child given for the salvation of the world.

2. Light in the Shadows – John 1:4–5

Jesus is the Light the world longed for, breaking through spiritual darkness with a hope that no night can overcome.

3. Mary's Yes – Luke 1:26–38

A tender, powerful reflection on Mary's courage and surrender, saying 'yes' to God's plan and becoming the vessel of His grace.

4. Stand in the Light – Matthew 1:18–25

Honoring Joseph's quiet strength as he chooses obedience over fear, stepping boldly into God's plan to protect Mary and the Child.

5. Born in the Quiet Night – Luke 2:1–7

A humble, wonder-filled portrait of Jesus' birth in a manger, where heaven's King chose the lowliest place to enter our world.

6. Glory in the Highest – Luke 2:8–14

A majestic song echoing the angels' proclamation of peace, as heaven erupts in worship over the birth of Christ.

7. Run to the Wonder – Luke 2:15–20

Following the shepherds as they hurry to see the newborn Savior, inviting us to run with the same awe, urgency, and faith.

8. Star Over the Nations – Matthew 2:1–10

A cinematic journey with the Magi as they follow the star, guided by God toward the Light of the world.

9. Gifts for the King – Matthew 2:11

Unpacking the prophetic meaning of gold, frankincense, and myrrh, and what their worship teaches us about honoring Jesus today.

10. Under Wings of Midnight – Matthew 2:13–15

A dramatic reminder of God's protection as the Holy Family flees, showing that even in the darkest hours, He leads and preserves.

11. When God Says It's Time – Matthew 2:19–23

A gentle, hopeful song about God's perfect timing as He calls them back home, turning seasons of waiting into stories of restoration.

12. For Every Nation, For Every Soul – Luke 2:30–32; John 3:16

The grand finale declaring Jesus as Savior for all people,

from every land and generation—Emmanuel, God with us forever.
