



When you are considering hiring a remodeling contractor for your home, you should consider the following:

1. How long have they been in business?

A good contractor will be in business for at least 10 years. A bad one will only be in business for a few months before they are out of business.

2. What is their experience?

The more experience a contractor has, the better they will do the job for you. They will have done hundreds if not thousands of projects just like yours. This means that they will know what to look for and how to handle any problems that may arise.

3. How much will the project cost?

This is a very important question because it will tell you how much money you can afford to spend. The average cost of a remodel is between \$10,000 and \$15,000. If the project will cost less than \$5,000, then you can probably get away with doing the project yourself. However, if the project costs more than \$5,000, you will need to find a contractor who will work within your budget.

4. Will the contractor offer a warranty?

If they don't offer a warranty, then you should avoid them. Most contractors offer a warranty, but not all do. You want to make sure that the contractor offers a warranty that covers the materials used and the workmanship.

5. Will they be available when you need them?

Some contractors will only be available during the day while others will be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. If you are having a problem and you need someone right away, then you want to hire someone who will be available at any time of the day or night.

6. Will they be there when you need them?

This is a big deal because most people are going to need their help when they are working on the project. If the contractor does not show up when you need them, then you will need to call another contractor. This can cause a lot of stress and wasted time.

7. What is their reputation?

You should check into the reputation of the contractor by looking at reviews on the Internet. You can also ask friends and family members for referrals.

8. How do they treat their customers?

A good contractor should be friendly and courteous to everyone. They should be willing to answer questions and provide honest answers to any concerns you may have. They should also be willing to come back and finish the job if you need them to.

9. How much will the project take?

A good contractor is going to give you an estimate of how long the project will take and how much it will cost. If they do not give you an estimate, then you should keep looking.

10. What is the guarantee?

The guarantee should be something like a year's worth of labor and materials. It should cover everything from the materials used to the workmanship.
